Pierre Boussaguet is one of the important bass players on the jazz scene today. Based in Paris, France, he splits his time between concerts worldwide and the recording studio.

With Ray Brown, who took him under his wing, he founded the band "Two Bass Hits" in 1988, followed by tours and two memorable albums of bass duets.

Pierre is a "first call" sideman and has performed with, among others, Clark Terry, Joe Pass, Monty Alexander, Tommy Flanagan, Milt Jackson, Wynton Marsalis, Diana Krall ("The Look Of Love Tour, 2002) Lalo Schifrin (Jazz Meets The Symphony)

Since 2010 Pierre is Michel Legrand's bassist.
